Arturo Vargas Escobar holds a BA in Anthropology from, School of Humanities of the University of the Andes (Bogota) and a PhD from the Aristotelian University of Thessalonica . During his studies he participated as an assistant and as a research associate researcher in the Department of Anthropology. When he completed his studies he worked at the Institute of Anthropology of Colombia (ICAN) as an archaeologist. He also participated as research associate in various scientific projects in Colombia, among them the most important: «Tayrona in Lost City» at Sierra Nevada of Santa Marta.
